The Alien Nation Rally, our Kelly Kampouts, the shuttlecraft "Galileo" discovery, the Trappers game, Tom Foolery at the Broadway Stage then meeting Bill Sargent (Dr. Thomas Leighton), visiting Hansen Planetarium, Patrick Stewart's "One Man Christmas Carol", our rocket launches, the "Kelly Movie", our Horta Egg Hunts, bowling, Space Shuttle "Discovery" VIP, Star Trek Day at Media Play, kite flying, Laser Quest, Dinosaur Day at Hogle Zoo, tubing, Cyberspace, the Voyager missions at the Christa McAuliffe Space Education Center, Star Trek Lagoon days, miniature golf, the Talent Show, Star Wreck, the Klingon Klass, the Star Party at the U of U, Knowledge Night, our Halloween parties, Haagan-Daz contests, Festival of Trees, ping pong, CONduit's SIG contests (took 1st place in '94 and '95), the Kelly van "Powell", helping Rick Blair with his fiber optic models, Game Night, building the Star Trek Generations theater display, Training Sheet Night and seeing such movies as: "The Villian", "Home Alone", "Three Men and a Little Lady", "Batman", "Spaced Invaders", and "ID4".

We have also enjoyed our association with other groups, in doing: paintball (Kelly Krackshots) and milking goats with the USS Rendezvous, a trivia competition (which we won) and softball with the USS Dominion, a video marathon with Rebel's Associated, the Collywobble picnic and waterfight, visiting Hill Air Force Base Air Museum with the USS Euphrates, and attending the USS Fahrion's Christening and later joining with them at Raging Waters. We have also been active in the "Captain's Rountable" in the hopes of improving relations with the other groups.

We have been service minded as well, with: the Robert Heinlein blood drives, Pioneer State Park clean-up, answering phones for KUED telethons, reading books at the Primary Children's Hospital, helping at Space Talk '94 and '95, visiting the Homeless Shelter, giving presentations to the Cub Scouts and Headstart Pre-school programs, making quilt blocks, earning money to help fight Battens Disease, and even decorating a Christmas tree for Emily Meacham at the West Jordan Care Center. We have helped at many conventions and met such actors/actresses as: Grace Lee Whitney, Mark Lenard, Majel Barrett Roddenberry, Nichelle Nichols, Michael Dorn, Colm Meaney, Armin Shimmerman, Jimmy Doohan, John DeLancie, Marina Sirtis, Garrett Wang, Jennifer Hetrick, Max Grodenchik, Jonathan Del Arco and William Shatner. We have recycled aluminum cans, sold Golden Dragon Fireworks, had yard sales and Kelly auctions as fundraisers.

We are the second oldest Star Trek Fan Club in Utah and have grown into the largest, with 70 members (we have given out as many as 150+ orders). We have our own unique Starship design and logo. We have put out 41 issues of the "Kelly Communique" and have made Kelly t-shirts, jackets, communicators, pencils, key chains and even candy.

What a privileged it was to celebrate our 10th Anniversary at a Charity Luncheon with Chase Masterson (Leeta) to benefit "Caring for Babies with Aids". You couldn't describe our voyage any better than with the words, "To the USS Kelly, In Recognition of 10 Years of Outstanding Community Service and Fellowship", found on a plaque presented to us from CINEMAholics.

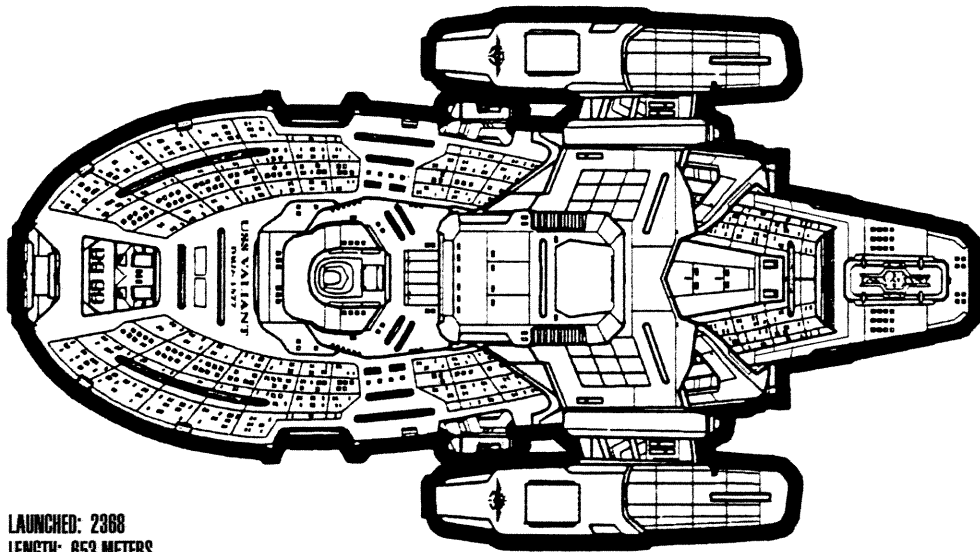

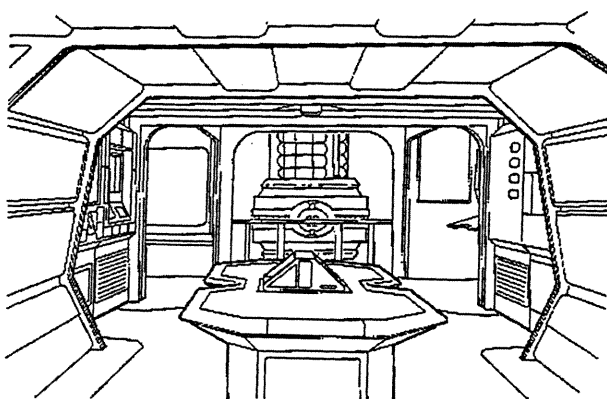


Engineering Info.

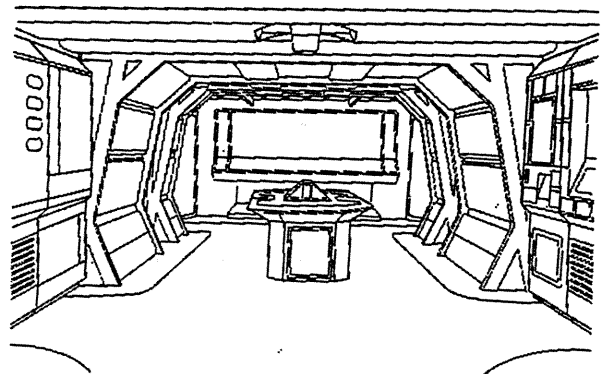
The Main Engineering control center is located on deck 36. The Main Engineering control center for the saucer section is located on deck 4, between the bridge and the nacelle sections. The engineering sections serve as master control for the ship's warp propulsion systems and other engineering systems.

Main Engineering also serves as a backup control center in the event of failure of the

Main Bridge and the Battle Bridge. Workstations at these locations can be reconfigured to emulate Conn, Ops, Tactical, and other command operations. This is a desirable site for such functions because of its protected location within the Engineering section and its proximity to key warp propulsion system components. Optical data network hardlines provide protected backup communications to other major systems.

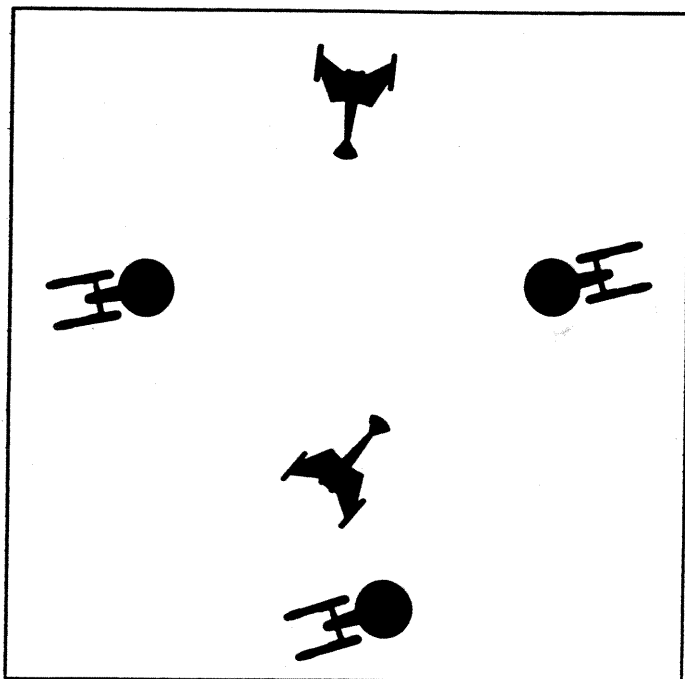
