I don't know about you, but I was bothered with the episode "Darkling". For seven years I watched in vain for some of my favorite characters of "Star Trek: The Next Generation" to come together. How many of us cheered when Picard kissed Beverly in "Allegiance", too bad it wasn't really him. Later we hear Picard say to Beverly, "I felt guilty before he (Jack Crusher) died... having those kind of feelings (love) for my best friend's wife. Then... later, after the accident... I told myself I would never let you know how I felt." ("Attached"). That wasn't what I wanted to hear. Then in the last episode "All Good Things..." we find Capt. Beverly Picard and I said to myself "It's about time." But then again we find they were not able to make their marriage work.

What about Riker and Troi. "Do you remember what I taught you, Imzadi? Can you still sense my thoughts?" (Troi in "Encounter at Farpoint"). "Imzadi" became a special word to my wife and me, describing how we felt about each other. But throughout the series what Riker wants most is to captain a starship, and the series ends with "I just... never could admit it was over. I kept thinking one day we'd get together again... and then... she was gone." (Riker in "All Good Things..."). I was thinking the same thing all along, one day they'd get together.

When I ask the writers and producers about these concerns, they tell me it would limit their story lines and in how they could develop the characters. So, they have been guilty of not bringing people together for these reasons but for the first time in "Darkling" they pulled two people apart!

I remember the love Kes showed Neelex by giving him one of her lungs. I remember Neelex saying, "When I first met you, I didn't know that your species only lived eight or nine years. I fell in love with you without knowing how lonely it would be to live without you after you're gone..." and Kes responding, "Before I met you, eight or nine years seemed like an eternity. It never occurred to me that anyone could live longer. Now that we're together, no matter how many years we have left, it doesn't seem long enough. But the important thing is to cherish whatever time we have together. Whether it's a day or a decade." ("Jetrel"). That almost sounds like a wedding vow to me. And all this is casually dismissed with "Your recent break-up with Mr. Neelex." (Dr. Zimmerman).

This tends to lead one to believe, once you're married life is over. Our theme this year is "We're Family". My wife, children and friends give my life purpose. They are why I boldly go where no one has gone before. Let us do the 24th Century one better by staying together.

The animal guide of the U.S.S. Kelly is the bear. The captain has urged us to study our animal guide to see what we can learn from its example.

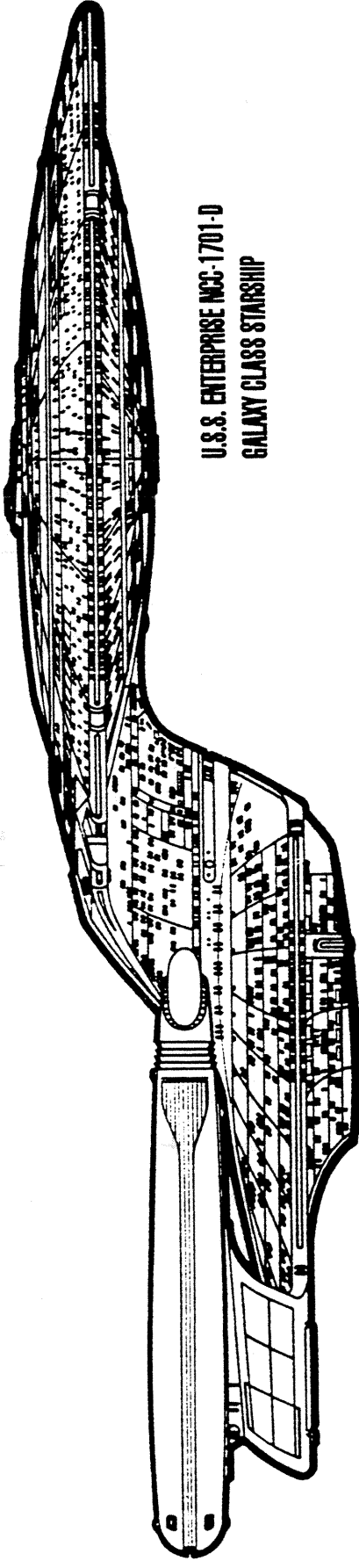

### ***DONNA YATES***

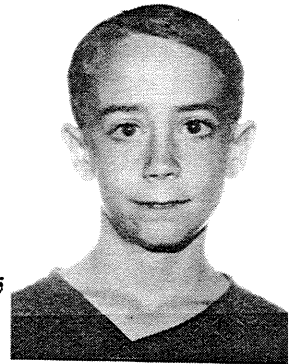

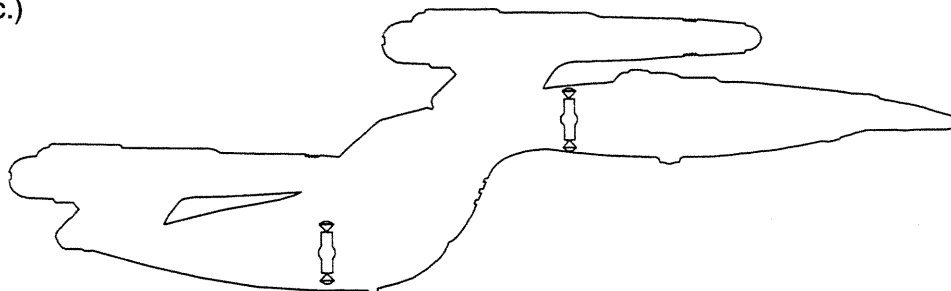

# TACTICALLY SPEAKING

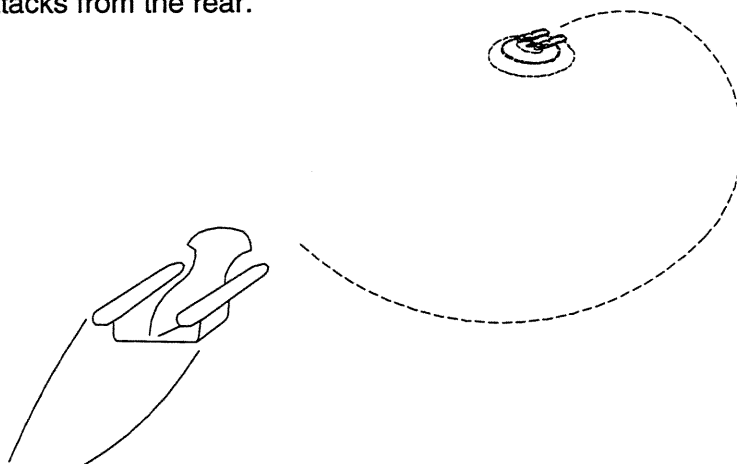

As I approach my next rank advancement, I realized I was missing something. Part of being a Senior Officer and advancing in rank is the training of suitable and capable replacements. I have not provided some of the knowledge needed to those coming after me. As such, I thought I would pass on some of the unique tactical capabilities of the USS Kelly to her new Tactical Officers. Here are a few possible Tactical Strategies for potential engagements:

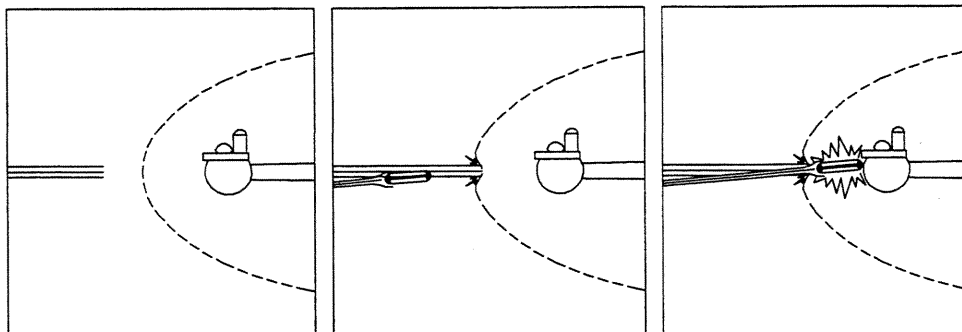
1. Operate in joined cruise mode cloaked. (This gives us the ability yo fire while cloaked) Remember that while in joined flight mode there is no plasma being transferred within the upper nacelles and all power generated by the primary hull warp core can be utilized for functions other than propulsion. (i.e., weapons, shields, cloaking device, etc.)



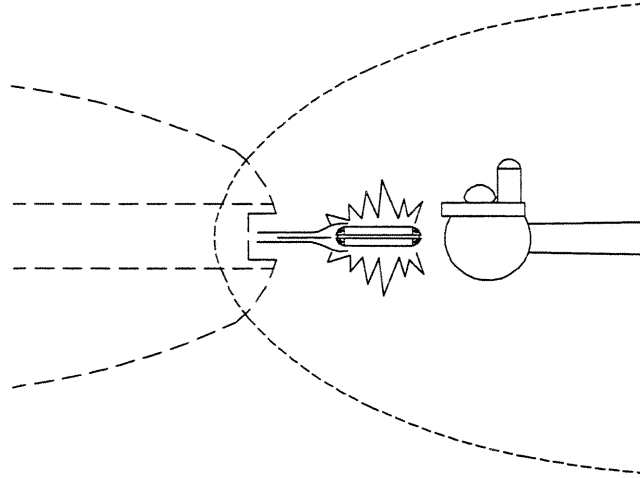
2. Cloak Saucer. Separate Stardrive and Saucer sections (not detectable at long range). Close on target with Stardrive section (maintains warp signature) while Saucer circles around and attacks from the rear.



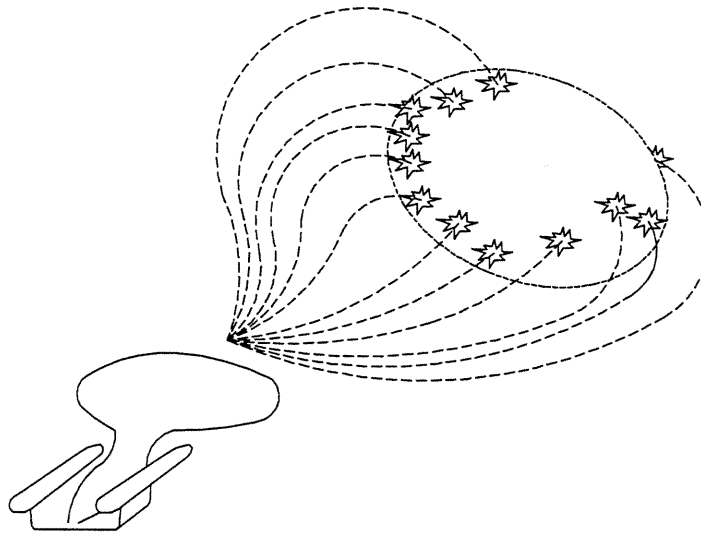
3. Phaser dimple the target to allow penetration of photon torpedo. The pressure from the phaser beam on the threat vessel's shields can create an opening that the photon torpedoes can penetrate, exploding within the target vessel's shields.



4. Use the phase cloaking device to allow penetration of threat vessel's shields by photon torpedo. Once the photon torpedo has left the phase cloak field it will return to normal space and explode within the target's shields.

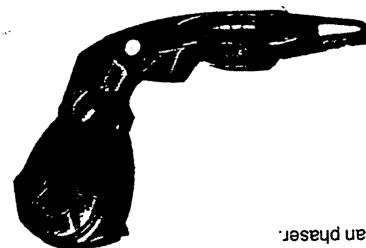


5. Use the Mezia concept to full advantage. With up to 80 photon torpedoes under remote control converging simultaneously on a threat vessel it is easy to see how they could quickly overwhelm the target's point defenses and shields.

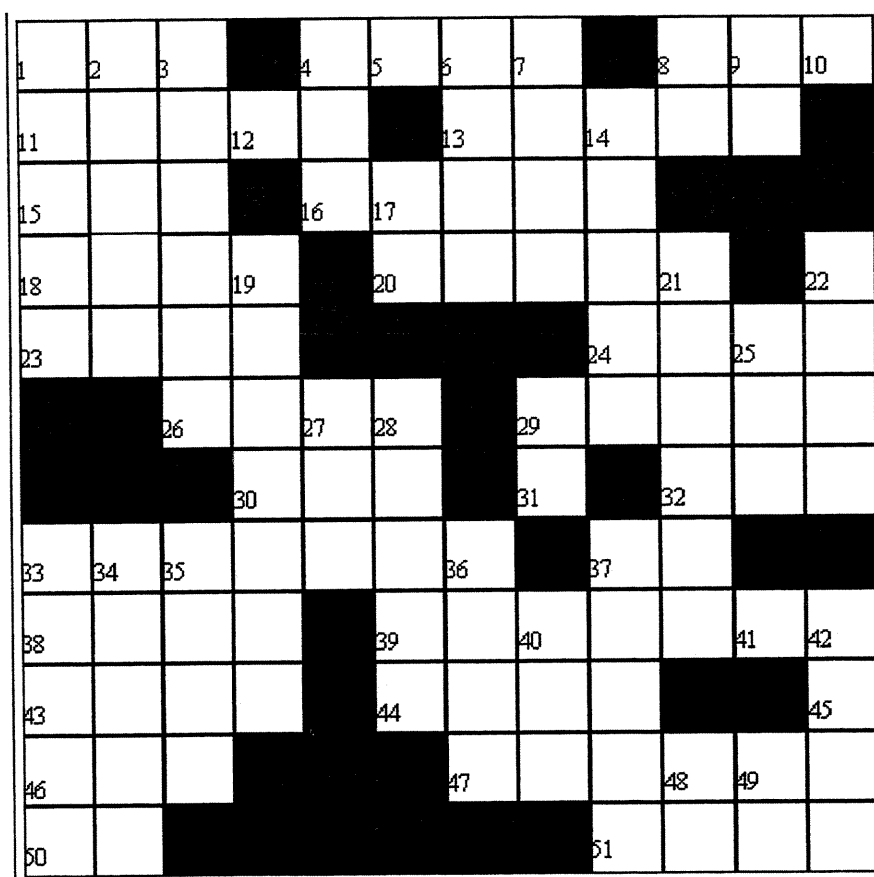
